- the "Build Fund" is a "designated" separate fund used to pay off Bethel's mortgages ("designated" means that money donated there cannot be used for anything else).

- in the "useful-to-know" department, it has been suggested in the past that if your donations to Bethel are divided 2/3 towards the General fund and 1/3 towards the Build fund, everything usually gets covered. But that is up to you!
