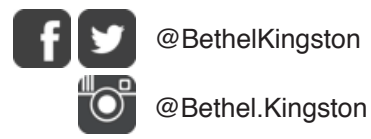

 - The nursery will be open but unstaffed for access to a change table and wash-room for babies and young children.
- No Coffee & Conversation, but we will *encourage everyone to connect after the service in your own fun ways to enjoy the summer evenings!*
