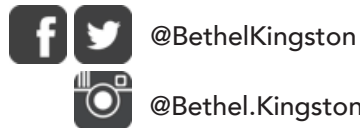

JANUARY BENEVOLENT FOOD DRIVE | In lieu of a benevolent offering this month, we will be holding a Food Drive to support the Salvation Army Emergency Food Pantry.
