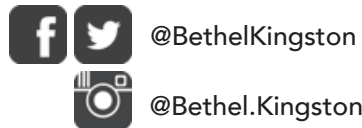
BABY DEDICATION | We celebrate with three young families as they commit to raising their children in the ways of the Lord. As a congregation, we also commit to support and pray these families!
