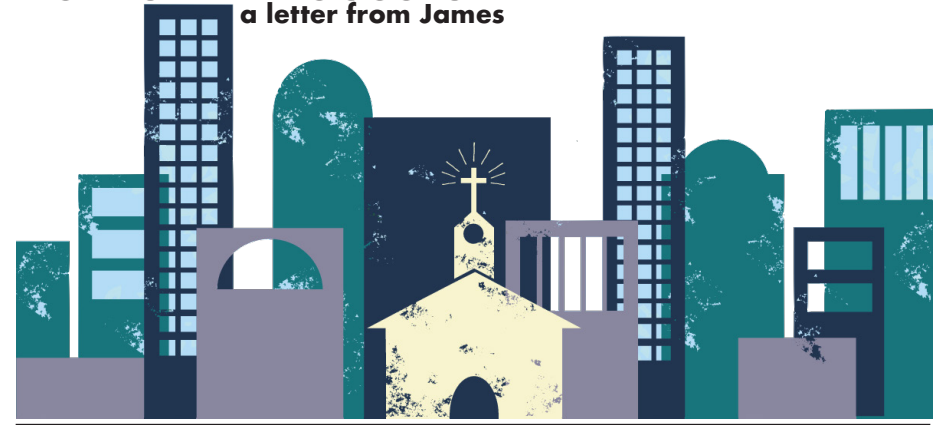

GOAT ISLAND | Pray for the men and boys camping on Goat Island this weekend. Pray for good friendships, safety in activities, and Spirit-filled worship.

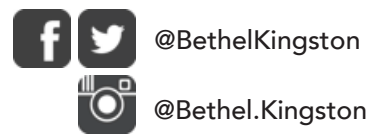
